

Strong connections among parents, teachers, and students enhance the educational experience for everyone.





ELECTION YEAR!


This year is also an election year for all positions. In order to run for the PTO, please keep in mind you must commit to the following:

- 1. Eligibility. Any Member who has attended two of the previous four general PTO meetings and participated in at least two sponsored PTO events as a volunteer is eligible for nomination as an Officer. *
- 2. Each Officer shall have the duty of loyalty, good faith and to act in the best interest of the PTO in the exercise of their Office. Each Officer shall attend every general meeting of the PTO and participate in all PTO sponsored events.



*Elections will be held at the final PTO meeting of the year. Which means, to be eligible to run, you must attend at least 2 PTO meetings this year. However, we encourage all those interested to attend all events, and as many meetings as possible throughout the year.
